Preschool Uniform and Dress Code for Students 18 months - 4 years old

### GIRLS

#### Everyday Uniform Choices

- Polo shirt (red, navy or white) with the Logo and Khaki skirt (preferably with bike shorts), skort, shorts or pants (K1 and K2 students do not require the Logo on their polo shirts)
- Navy polo dress with bike shorts underneath with white socks or white/black tights
- Navy red plaid skort
- Navy cardigan or vest with the Logo
- Navy zip-up hoodie jacket with the Logo
- Girls may choose white or black tights or leggings, along with socks of the same color as the navy polo dress or navy red plaid skort.
- Navy blue, red or plaid flat headbands or hair ribbons (such as Jojo Bows) are permitted.
- No jewelry should be worn except stud or small hoop earrings.

#### Special Occasion Uniform Choices

- Navy red plaid jumper with the Logo (For All Ages)
- White blouse (short or long sleeve) with the Logo *\*\*Polos CANNOT be worn with the jumper\*\**
- Girls adjustable tie
- White tights or White socks.
- White, black or gray tennis Shoes or Mary Jane uniform shoes
- Navy cardigan with the Logo
- Navy blue, red or plaid flat headbands or hair ribbons (such as Jojo Bows) are permitted.

### BOYS

#### Everyday Uniform Choices

- Polo shirt (red, navy or white) with the Logo paired with Khaki shorts or pants (K1 and K2 students do not need the Logo on their polo shirts)
- Navy cardigan or vest with the Logo
- Navy zip-up hoodie jacket with the Logo
- Boys may choose SOLID white, gray, or black socks.

#### Special Occasion Uniform Choices

- White Oxford shirt (short or long sleeve) with the Logo
- Khaki pants
- Boys adjustable tie for K4 or bow tie for K1-K3
- Navy vest with the Logo
- Boys may choose SOLID white, gray, or black socks

#### Additional Uniform Guidelines

- Students may wear their special occasion uniform every day if they wish. Polos CANNOT be worn with the jumper. Attire should be clean and practical for active play. Shirts do not have to be tucked in.

- Shoes must be safe and practical for active play. Tennis shoes are recommended for all grade levels but not required. Any brand of shoe is acceptable, provided they are: one SOLID color of white, black, or gray, closed toe, closed heel, and rubber sole. Preschool students must wear shoes with velcro fasteners. Shoes with lights, flip-flops, sandals, boots (including rain boots or snow boots), crocs, and wheeled shoes are not acceptable.
- All shoes must be always worn with socks. Socks should be solid colors as indicated above.
- On Wednesdays, students need to wear spirit wear t-shirts or the red uniform shirts.
- During the colder months, students should wear long sleeve shirts and laying of long shirts under short sleeved shirts is not allowed.
